The 'action map' inside this leaflet shows the kind of things we will be running during the week, where they are, and how you as a local resident can get involved. All our activities are **FREE** and they are all about making sure things are really up to scratch in your neighbourhood. Turn the page to find out more!

DAY 1 ENVIRONMENT

Monday

We will start off the week by doing rubbish bag searches, flytip, dog fouling and abandoned vehicle investigations around the area. We will also be looking at other cleansing issues and monitoring this throughout the week.

DAY 5 ENVIRONMENT

Friday

We will finish off the week by looking at bin collections and other bin-related problems in the area. We will also be raising awareness of bin fires on the day and reviewing all the work that's taken place over the week.

DAY 2 HOUSING & ADVICE

Tuesday

Based in and around Peggotty Road Community Centre, Great Yarmouth Community Housing and a range of other agencies will be providing housing, benefits, and other types of advice and support. The Area Housing Panel meeting will also be taking place at 3.30pm at the Community Centre as part of the day's activity.

Thursday

Wednesday

Based around the shops on Barkis Road, a range of agencies will be on hand to provide you with information on healthy eating, exercise, and other services. We will also be handing out healthy goodie bags. Why not stop for a nice healthy smoothie if you're in the area?
