- Welcomes/ Introductions** Rob welcomed everyone to the meeting. Introductions were made around the table.

2. **Minutes of last meeting** Agreed and approved as accurate
3. **Matters Arising**
- Sea of Trees**
Still to be approached re state of their area on St. Nicholas Playing field.
- Action:Holly Notcutt to follow up.**
- Nelson Road South**
Outstanding issues still with properties on Nelson Road South
- Action: Glenn Buck to follow-up**
4. **Performance of projects** Members were circulated expenditure and outcome reports for funded projects.
- Grey 2 Green – Mike Brackenbury**
3 schemes currently underway at Runham Vauxhall, Victoria Place, Louise Close. Match funding being sought by Norfolk County Council and Great Yarmouth Community Housing.
- Glass Recycling – Rob Gregory**
New provision at the Clipper Schooner.
- Action: To follow up with First Move for the provision of a third bin.**
- Clear Bag Schemes – Peter Stockwell**
This will commence on 10th November 2008.
- NEMO**
To consider rear of King Street (North end) both sides as a future location.
5. **Litter Bin Locations** GYB Services have plotted quantity and quality of litter bins across the neighbourhood. This will be transferred to an electronic format. The group will spend time at the next meeting exploring where issues are currently occurring. This could be a potential project for delivery in 09/10.
- Action: Mark Naylor to prepare maps for distribution.**
6. **My Back Yard – Way Forward** ‘My Back Yard’ had been developed as an idea to create community ownership of streets in South Yarmouth. It would encourage residents to sign-up to being in a MBY scheme – which would mean they were willing to keep areas outside of their properties clean and tidy. Participants would receive incentives, e.g. a free bulky item collection, and each area would receive a plaque to demonstrate community ownership.
- St. Georges Road agreed as a pilot location.

Action: Holly Notcutt (CDW) to work with residents to move project forward.

7. **March

Campaign**

The group decided the concept of the March campaign should be a visual demonstration of the success of the pride initiatives i.e a sculpture of fly-tip, with a Great Yarmouth background stating the percentage of reduction in fly-tips, in South Yarmouth.
